How to Use The Life of Jesus TalkCards

- **In Small Groups** – Print, display, or send a TalkCard to each person in the group, then talk about the question with the whole group or in Foursomes, Trios, or Pairs. If you break into smaller groups for conversation around the TalkCard, come back together to share what groups talked about.
- **In Church Classes** – Choose a TalkCard that fits with a topical focus or Scriptural connect and embed it into the plan for the lesson. Or “curate” several TalkCards into one lesson and add your own Introduction and Closing to create your own lessons.
- **On Retreats and Spiritual Gatherings** – Use TalkCards for your community morning or evening devotions, or send them to participants for their personal devotions. Add them into your retreat plan as ways to refocus on Jesus throughout your time together, or curate them into an entire retreat plan.
- **For Personal Devotions** – Treat each TalkCard as a devotional, moving through them from beginning to end.
- **In Worship Services** – Embed TalkCards in your worship service by putting them on your screen before and after the service, or by using them as talk-starters in the flow of your service (just get pairs talking to one another), or as opening or closing liturgical elements.
